

As Scientists we will ...

observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants, which will build upon prior learning of understanding the basic structure of a variety of flowering plants and trees. We will discover what the variety of wild and garden plants and trees, identified in Year 1, need to grow and stay healthy: water, light and a suitable temperature.

As Historians we will ...

explore local history to develop our knowledge of travel, exploration and society. We will make links with prior learning about explorers and compare modes of transport with Amy Johnson's plane. We will further develop previous knowledge about the locations visited by explorers as we learn the flight path of Amy's journey to Australia. We will demonstrate an understanding of the chronological timeline of the key events of Amy Johnson's life, education and pilot training and how the legacy of our local history is commemorated in our city.

In Art and Design we will ...

work with textiles to plan and design our own bookmark or certificate. We will select from and use a range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks such as cutting and joining fabrics.

In Computing we will ...

continue to create and debug simple programs and use logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of simple programs. We will also develop our digital literacy skills when using Chromebooks. images. We will also continue learning about e-safety.

identify and describe the properties of 3D shapes before looking closely at money.

We will continue to develop our understanding of addition and subtraction of two, 2-digit numbers.

We will develop our understanding of multiplication when representing equal groups and we will continue to count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10.

In RE we will ...

explore the question 'What is true?' and consider our own beliefs.
