### As Geographers we will...

Use maps, atlases, globes and digital mapping to locate the countries and major cities of the United Kingdom and Europe. We will understand the difference between human and physical features of the different countries and will compare and contrast them. We will ask and answer geographically valid questions relating to the countries we are focusing on. Furthermore, we will learn about the variations in the weather and climate of the countries in question.
