As readers, we will...

As mathematicians, we will...

As scientists, we will...

identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating.

Recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear. Recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases. Find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it.

In computing, we will...

develop our knowledge of how to use technology respectfully and responsibly, including on apps, games and websites.

Develop programming skills through our use of Turtle Academy and Scratch.
