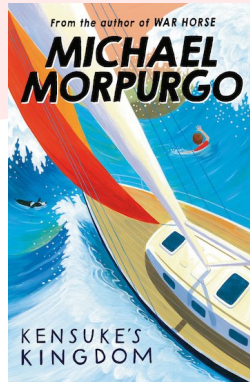


Spring 2 Year 5
